35 hours Level 1 Instructor – Advice

Dear Member,

A total of 35 hours minimum of teaching/ski school experience is part of the Level 1 Instructor qualification. These hours must be completed after successful completion of the Level 1 Instructor course. The idea of this is to help you develop an understanding of BASI's philosophies.

Hours gathered before attending the Level 1 Course, do not count towards the 35hrs, as we perceive the information you gain from the Level 1 Course will enhance your understanding of BASI philosophies.

Ski school experience can range from observing lessons to taking bookings and administration, to equipping clients with clothing/skis etc.

PLEASE NOTE: The breakdown of the 35 hours of ski school experience must be on your ski school headed paper or other official document, to demonstrate proof that you have completed this requirement.

On completion the information can be sent to the office by post or fax. If you wish to email it, then as it needs to be signed you must first scan in the document, so proof of signature is received.

This has to be done so an audit trail is made and in order to protect the level of qualification and to keep it fair for all.

You will not be able to gain your Level 1 Instructor Qualification without these hours.
