### **70 hour ski school experience, Level 2 Instructor – Advice**

Dear Member,

One of the pre-requisites for the Level 2 Instructor course is 70hrs of ski school experience. **The first 35 hours are to be completed after passing the Level 1 Instructor course and is required for you to gain the qualification. The second 35 hours are to be completed before attending the Level 2 training and assessment course**

The idea of this is to help you develop an understanding of BASI's philosophies, have experience in using those in a practical sense and learn from that experience to better prepare you for the next level

Hours gathered before attending the Level 1 Course do not count towards the 70hr requirement, as we perceive that the information gained from the Level 1 Course will enhance your understanding of BASI philosophies.

Ski school experience can range from observing lessons to taking bookings and carrying out administration duties or providing clients with clothing/skis etc.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The breakdown of the ski school experience must be on ski school headed paper or any other official document proving that you have completed this requirement. It is preferred that you have at least 50% of your ski school as teaching or shadowing rather than most of the experience being at a reception desk. Common sense prevails as to what is the most useful experience that is going to help you throughout your BASI progression, not just getting over a hurdle!

Students should preferably complete their hours prior to booking the Level 2 Instructor Course with the office, however it is recognised that you may wish to book onto a course before completing all the required hours. In order to accommodate this, BASI will accept a booking at this point although it must be stressed that:

**IF ALL SIGNED HOURS ARE NOT RECEIVED AT THE BASI OFFICE FIVE DAYS PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE, THEN YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND THE COURSE AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUND.**

**IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ORGANISE THIS IN A TIMELY MANNER.**

This has to be done so an audit trail is made and to ensure that quality control and consistency of the level of qualification is retained to safeguard the qualification's credibility in the market place.
