Despite the recent financial crisis that affected Snowsports GB, the newly formed organisation British Ski and Snowboarding under the leadership of BOA Chairman, Colin Moynihan, will continue to be supported by BASI to assist with the coaching of athletes at the highest level. Given the difficulties that a shortage of resources has created for the athletes in terms of support and on-going funding, BASI recognises the significant achievements that the athletes continue to make.

BASI's support was no less evident than at the recent 2010 British Land Alpine Ski Championships in Meribel, France 29th March – 5th April. In return for funding for the employment of coaching staff at British Team level, coaches will attend selected BASI events and courses, to assist with the development and delivery of the BASI Coaching Scheme by BASI Trainers.
