BASI has recently carried out a thorough investigation with the administrators of the MoU scheme as to what the exact regulations are for the BASI instructors to receive a MoU stamp. This investigation which was started in September 2017, reached its conclusion recently and the requirements are as follows:

- The instructor must hold his or her highest national qualification and have passed the Eurotest and EMS, or;
- Have exemption to the Eurotest by holding FIS points of less than 100 for men, or less than 85 for women, or;
- Hold his or her highest national qualification and have established, recognised equivalence in another signatory state, before 6th February 2012.

BASI is authorised to issue the stamp to eligible members, the MoU administrators are the official awarding body of the MoU stamps. They are the sole entity who are able regulate the criteria for admission to the MoU scheme and eligibility for an MoU stamp. In the event that you wish to challenge the criteria against which MoU stamps are issued, you should direct your challenge to Directorate-General GROW for Internal Markets, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs.
